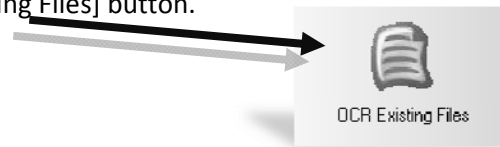


OCR Existing Files

This option allows the user to OCR existing supported image files and save the text files in the same directory of the original images.

To begin, click on the [OCR Existing Files] button.

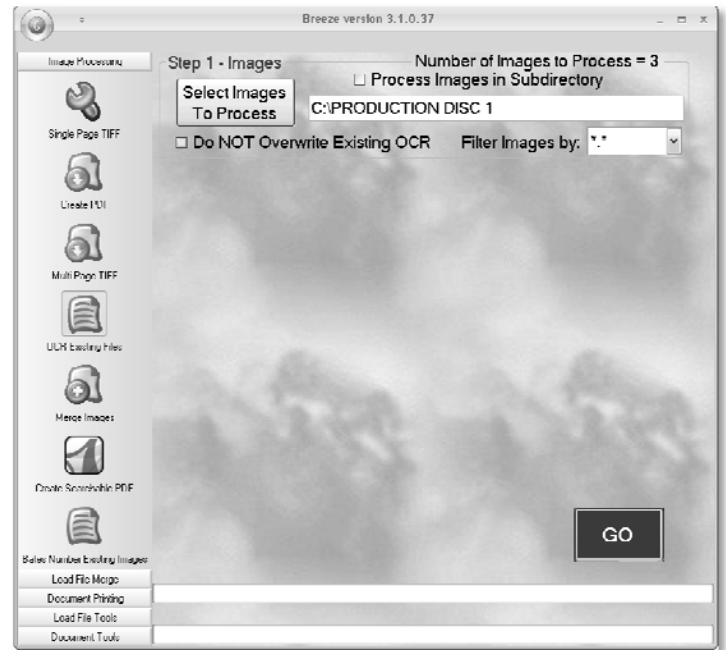


Step 1 - Images

Select Images to Process

- (1) Click on the [Select Images to Process] button
- (2) Browse to the volume which contains the image files you wish to OCR and click [OK]

**Make sure you check the box next to "Process Images in Subdirectory" if your image volume contains subfolders



Do NOT Overwrite Existing OCR

This option tells Breeze not to OCR image files which already have corresponding .TXT files. The .TXT file containing the OCR must be named the same as the image file.

GO

Once all of the required settings are set, the [GO] button will appear. Click the [GO] button to start the conversion.

The OCR text files will be saved in the same directory where the original image files are located. Both single-page TIF and multi-page TIF files can be OCR'd using this option.
